To the Honorable the Circuit Court of the United States, in and for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania:

The Petition of *James Henry Hinchliffe*
A NATIVE OF *England*

Respectfully Showeth,

That he declared on oath before *the Clerk of the Court of Quarter Sessions*
of County of Philadelphia

on the *3rd* day of *October* A. D. 18*85* that it was bona fide his intention to become a citizen of the United States, and of renouncing forever all allegiance and fidelity to any Foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereignty whatever, and particularly to the QUEEN OF GREAT BRITAIN AND IRELAND of whom he was at that time a subject. That your petitioner has resided within the United States upwards of five years, and one year in the State of Pennsylvania last past, immediately preceding this his application to become a Citizen of the United States.

That he has never borne any hereditary title or been of any of the orders of nobility in his own or any other country.

He therefore prays, that on his making the proof, and taking the oath prescribed by law, he may be admitted a Citizen of the United States of America.

And he will ever pray, &c.

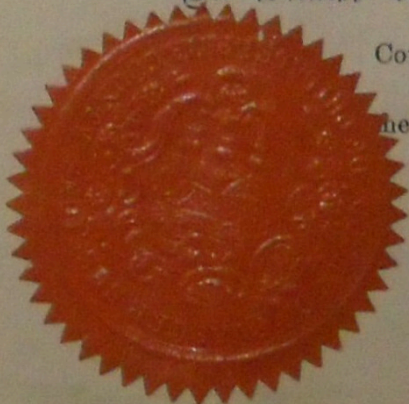

of whom he is now a subject.

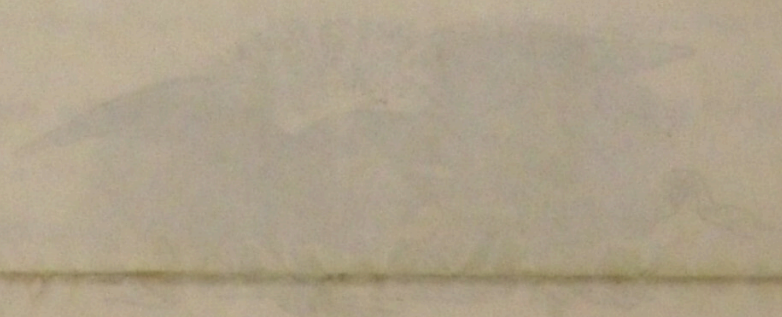
