The Petition of *John Keys.*  
A Native of *Ireland*

Respectfully Sheweth:

That he declared on oath before the Clerk of this Court, on the *12<sup>th</sup>* day of *September* A. D. 18*90* that he had arrived in the Port of *New York* on or about the *15.* day of *June* in the year *1877* and being at that time *9* years of age, and that at the time of his arrival he was under eighteen years of age; that he has continued to reside in the United States since that period; that for three years previous to his arrival at full age, it was and still is *bona-fide* his intention to become a Citizen of the United States, and of renouncing forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereignty whatever, and particularly to the *Queen of Great Britain Ireland & Scotland* of whom he was at that time a Subject. That your Petitioner has resided within the United States upwards of five years, and one year in the State of Pennsylvania last past, immediately preceding this his application to become a Citizen of the United States.

That he has never borne any hereditary title, or been of any of the orders of nobility in his own or any other country.

He therefore prays that, on his making the proof and taking the oath prescribed by law, he may be admitted a Citizen of the United States of America.
